# **Voices of Change - SMU Parking**

The best place to drop off patrons needing an elevator is still the South entrance in the H lot. If they are able to walk a bit, the drop off loop on Hillcrest brings them to the entrance by the Hamon Library which is open and leaves them on the first floor. The Garson entrance is even more handicapped accessible but a farther walk. SMU states that all entrances to the building will be open by the 19<sup>th</sup>. Very limited parking on a first come first served basis will be open in the H lot, directly south of Owens Fine Arts Center/Meadows.

Another suggestion would be that patrons wishing to be dropped off do so at the H lot entrance, then drivers may park there or in the Meadows Museum, Hillcrest, Moody or Binkley garages. Please come early and bring your patience, it is a bit of a new environment for all of us, but with expanded patron areas, new restrooms and beautiful appointments it should enhance our concert attendance experience.

### Meadows Parking Center (F, 71)

No resident parking Level 1 (P1) Employee F permit and museum visitors (street level) Level 2 (P2) Student commuter permits Meadows has one entrance located on the south end of the garage and one exit located on the north: Left entrance Student commuter permits Right entrance Museum visitors.

#### Hillcrest Parking Center (I, 27)

Level 1 HPUMC parking Level 2 Employee I permit required, H/C Level 3–4 Student resident permits.

## Moody Parking Center (B, 99)

Level 1–2 Employee B permits required, H/C Level 3–5 Student commuter permits.

#### **Binkley Parking Center (C, 64)**

No resident parking Level 1 Employee C permit required Level 2 Visitors only, no students or employees Level 3–5 Student commuter permits.
